A 'normal' workday for a Dental Nurse will consist of the following core responsibilities:

- Preparing fillings and other materials
- * Providing support and reassurance to the patient
- Sterilising instruments
- Processing and filing x-rays
- Tidying and cleaning the dental surgery
- * Recording and filing information about patients
- * Advising patients on oral hygiene
- Carrying out stock control
